



## SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES

### 1. OFFICIAL UNIFORM PROVIDER

**The official uniform provider of Andersen International School is LM SCHOOL UNIFORMS.** Therefore it is forbidden to use and copy the Andersen logo on the clothing or school bags under threat of prosecution.

### 2. AGE GROUPS

**Nursery** children should wear comfortable clothes (track suit), appropriate to school and outdoor air activities that they do. A blue track suit and a white t-shirt are suggested. For all other students the Andersen International School uniform is compulsory and is not included in the school fee.

**Kindergarten** and **Reception** children can wear the sports uniform every day, while **from Y1** it is only possible to wear it on the days when there is PE or when the child attends an Andersen sport after-school activity.

### 3. EVERYDAY UNIFORM

Our everyday school uniform is made of: a blue pullover or gilet, a white polo t-shirt, blue trousers or Bermuda unisex shorts or skirt or a blue dress.

### 4. SPORTS UNIFORM

The sports uniform is made of trousers, shorts, pinocchietto trousers or leggings, T-shirts or sweatshirts.

### 5. SCHOOL TRIPS, EVENTS, CHOIR

During school trips or special events where directors expressly request it, from Y1 onwards, also the following items are compulsory: scarf for girls and tie for boys. Children in the choir need to wear, at choir performances, a white shirt, blue trousers/skirt, tie/scarf, and, if temperatures require it, a blue pullover. With the exception of the white T shirt, all the items are to be bought by the school official provider.

### 6. SHOES

Shoes (incl. PE trainers) and socks must be blue or black and can be purchased by any retailer, including the official one. Lace-up shoes are permitted only for children that are able to lace them up by themselves.

### 7. OTHER ITEMS

The following items are also part of the uniform, from Year 1 to Y4: a school bag (to be purchased in the school office), for Y5 and Y6 a trolley bag (to be bought by the official provider).

For Nursery and Kindergarten blankets for *sleep time* must be bought at the school office.
